How can Christian Friends of Korea work openly in North Korea?

With 3 Americans detained for many months and only recently released by the North Korean government, many people have asked us how it is that we can still work safely and openly as Christians in North Korea?

Of course it is a very delicate balance, but by encouraging us to focus on work that directly impacts and improves the lives and health of tens of thousands of ordinary North Koreans every year, the

North Korean government allows us to live out our faith openly and unambiguously among the people of the DPRK. What a privilege it is to sing hymns and read the Word together as a team every morning in North Korea, to pray together, asking for wisdom in our work, and God's blessing on those we encounter. This does not go unnoticed. In a conversation some time ago with a senior official, he remarked, "We know your team meets every morning to read and pray together..." I was

expecting a word of censure, or worse, to follow. Instead, he said, "Thank you for your prayers and hard work for our people. I want you to know that I will do everything I can to help your work."

1 John 1:18 teaches us that perfect love drives out fear. We pray that as we engage, work and live out our faith in North Korea, the perfect love and light of Jesus Christ will shine through us, dispelling darkness, bringing hope and healing, and driving out fear - to His glory.

There are now several patient care centers in North Korea that have improved so much with CFK's help that they can now stand more firmly on their own. We will continue to build our relationships with them and give limited support because neither we nor they want us to stop caring about those we have come to know and love. However, recently we have also been invited to expand our work. As our Ministry of Public Health colleague said to us in October, "You have provided a lot of help to many places – but there are many more places that have not received any help. Can you expand your work to include some new places?" Will you help us answer them with grace and compassion? Will you continue to faithfully pray and support CFK so that our work can touch many more lives, pointing them to the hope and healing found through faith in Jesus Christ?
